City as a regional context for architecture

- Subject:** The latest exhibition in Wiener Städtische Versicherungsverein's *Architektur im Ringturm* series is dedicated to Serbia, where architecture only emerged as an academic discipline in the late 19th century. Notable figures such as Branislav Kojić and Milan Zloković shaped the architectural evolution of the Serbian capital Belgrade during the 1920s and 1930s. As university lecturers and intellectuals they leave their mark on the entire country for generations. Bogdan Bogdanović was one of the most important personalities on the architecture scene in the post-1945 era. As an architect and mayor of Belgrade, he made a significant contribution to Serbia's architectural culture. The younger generation of architects is moving in new directions. This exhibition turns the spotlight on these trends and presents some of the country's outstanding constructions.
